## Bridal Shower

Abridal shower is a gift-giving party for a bride-to-be before her wedding. Traditionally, the bridal shower is attended by bridesmaids, but today, a mixed "Jack and Jill" party attended by both men and women is also common.


## Who are Bridesmaids?

The bridesmaids are members of the bride's party in a wedding. A bridesmaid is typically a young woman who is a close friend or sister of the bride. Bridesmaids customarily host the bridal shower.

Astag party is usually arranged by the groomsmen or the groom's male family members to celebrate the groom's last days of freedom as a single man. While there are no set rules concerning the events of a stag party, the evening is generally filled with males bonding over alcohol. It is also known as a bachelor party.
